Subject: Runyan Lake Inc. - High Water Level Alert

To All Riparian Members of Runyan Lake Inc.:

As of 5:30 PM today, the water level of Runyan Lake has risen at least 12 inches since Sunday evening. This is 12 inches above our typical lake level. With more rain expected, and observing several docks underwater and some wooden dock sections already floating in the lake, please take the following precautions to protect yourself and your neighbors:

- Please check the security of your watercraft to prevent them from going adrift;
- Please check the security of docks and other items in or near the water to prevent them from drifting off;
- If you plan to boat on the lake, please use caution and make as small a wake as possible. Boat wakes can damage shorelines, docks, and moored watercraft in these conditions. Remember, you are responsible for your own wake and any damage which results from your wake. Keep an eye out for floating objects;
- Please report any found items to me and we will send out a notice to find the owners. A picture is often helpful;
- Finally, please look out for your neighbors if they are away.

With additional rain on the way, the lake level may rise an additional few inches. It will likely take at least 2 days for enough water to spill over the dam to return the lake to a more normal level. **Please respect the shorelines of your neighbors and boat only at a slow/no wake speed until the lake level goes down.**
