Corrected Financial Report: For those who attended the 2015 Spring General Membership Meeting, an error was identified in the 2015 year to date financial report during the meeting. The summary numbers (Beginning Balance, Ending Balance, Increase/decrease) on the 04/30/2015 Financial Report presented at the General Membership Meeting and contained in the newsletter have been confirmed incorrect. Also, spring is finally here! As requested by a number of our Members, here are a few springtime reminders:

Thefts and Vandalism: Each year at this time we begin receiving notices of thefts and vandalism. It is easy to leave your front yard unattended while enjoying our backyards. Please check the security of your personal belongings and look out for any unexpected activity at your neighbors. Please be aware unattended and unlocked garages, homes, vehicles, etc. in today's world are simply an open invitation for many. Our perceived "escape" on Runyan Lake from the rest of the world simply no longer exists. Please look after your property, and that of your neighbors, so as to not invite additional undesired activities. Any suspicious activity should be reported to the Livingston County Sherriff by dialing 911. If you have had a recent break-in or attempted break-in we would appreciate knowing about it to better gauge activity in our immediate area and leverage additional patrols.

Loose Dogs: We have been asked to remind our Members dogs running loose is a hazard to both the dogs and humans. Complaints about wandering dogs, dogs chasing cars and joggers, and vicious behaving dogs in the roadways have been received. Dogs must remain within their property, else must be on a leash per local, county, and state ordinances and laws. Please respect your pets and neighbors and keep your pets within your property. Clean up after your dog when you are walking them. Complaints should be directed to Tyrone Township, Livingston County Animal Control, or the Livingston County Sheriff.

Boat Wake Damage: We continue to receive complaints about safety concerns and damage from boat wakes. While not trying to single out the wakeboard boats, those are the boats most often mentioned. All boat owners, and especially wakeboard boat owners – please keep in mind that while you are enjoying your boats and lake activities the wakes produced are often very large and affect other watercraft and our shorelines. Please maintain the required 100' separation from shore , other watercraft, and docks. By law, damage caused by boat wakes is the responsibility of the boat owner. Complaints should be directed to the Livingston County Sheriff.

Dogs On The Island: A dog waste station has been installed on the island. Please pick up after your dogs and take the waste with you for proper disposal. The island is used by Members and RLI for events and socializing. If you cannot clean up after your dogs we may have to ban them from the island.
