RUNYAN LAKE INCORPORATED - 2011 COMMITTEE FINANCIAL REVIEW

At the Spring 2012 Runyan Lake Incorporated (RLI) General Meeting the following members at large volunteered to conduct a financial review of the RLI books:

Norm Bacon Clay Putnam Dick Rappleye

RLI Treasurer Ivan Quinn e-mailed the above audit committee members the following information and organized a meeting time and place.

- A. Copies Of Monthly Bank Statements (PDF)
- B. Yearly Financial Report (Excel)
- C. Detail Of Yearly Receipts And Disbursements (Excel)
- D. Code (Account) Description Sheet (Excel)
- E. Summary Of Costs By Code (Excel)

Ivan asked committee members to perform individual review activities and prepare to discuss the audit with the Treasurer and the other committee members. The following tasks were performed individually by the committee members prior to the meeting:

- 1. Verified that 100% of the receipts and disbursements detail against the bank statements. No discrepancies were found.
- 2. Summarized costs by code category and ties out the amounts to what was reported on the final 2011 RLI Financial Report.
- 3. Tied out the year ending bank statement balance to total assets reported at year end on the 2011 RLI Financial Report.

On August 14, 2012 two of the committee members met with the Treasurer. One committee member could not be present, but had discussed his questions with the Treasurer by phone earlier that day. Both committee members described the pre-meeting audit activities that they had performed. The Treasurer was asked whether the books are on a "Cash" or "Accrual" basis. The treasurer confirmed that the RLI books use the accrual method. Discussion occurred regarding year end cut-off and an \$800 State Of Michigan payment. The books appeared to report the activity correctly from an accrual basis

Five expenditures were picked by the committee, and the Treasurer was asked to provide receipt detail and/or other documentation to support the expenditures. No problems were encountered. One dues deposit was selected and back up detail related to the deposit reviewed and discussed.

A lengthy discussion occurred between the Treasurer and Committee members regarding specific expenditures committee members had noted. Of primary importance was assurances that checks written to board members, gifts, and social committee events were discussed, authorized, and approved by a majority of the trustees Committee members were assured by the Treasurer that these expenditures were discussed and approved before being incurred.

OPINION

The committee members reviewed a sample of revenue (dues) and expenses for RLI reporting year. Based upon the limited scope audit review conducted by a membership committee who are not Trustees, it is our opinion that the financial statement prepared and presented to the RLI membership at the Spring 2012 General Membership meeting accurately represents financial activity for that year.
