2. Island Improvement Presentation

2.1. Ivan led the presentation. Two options were presented – (1) Use new riprap and backfill, and (2) Construct a seawall around the perimeter of the island. The bidding process, inclusive of the contractors, challenges, differences of opinions on materials, potential MDEQ permit and preliminary costs were all discussed. The island improvement committee recommended the seawall option as this was believed to be a superior solution. Ample time was provided for general discussion and questions.
