Initiation of any work on the permitted project confirms the applicant's acceptance and agreement to comply with all terms and conditions of the permit. Any noncompliance with terms of the permit constitutes a violation of the NREPA and is grounds for enforcement action.

The provisions of the renewed permit are severable. The renewed permit may be revoked during its term in accordance with applicable laws and rules.
