Subject: Runyan Lake Inc.: Fireworks, Ice Conditions, Water Level, Open Burning. Fire Extinguisher Recall Updates

To all Runyan Lake Inc. Members:

We wanted to share a few updates and cautions with everyone.

Fireworks Date – Due to the retirement of several crews at our fireworks show provider there are not enough crews available this year. Our proposed fireworks date of 7/7 does not have a crew available, therefore **the 2018 show will now occur on 6/30**. We understand this will be an inconvenience for some, but this date is our only option this year if we want a show.

Ice Conditions – Rain this week along with warm temperatures has deteriorated the ice on Runyan Lake. The ice is no longer safe for any activities in our opinion.

Water Level – The recent rains and melting snow, coupled with a still frozen ground have resulted in a higher than normal water level on Runyan Lake. Please check your items along the shoreline to be sure they are safe and secured. The water inflow from Denton Creek remains at its maximum rate so the water level will remain high for several more days at the very least.

Open Burning – Effective January 1, 2018, the burning of leaves and grass clippings is no longer permitted in residential areas such as Runyan Lake. If you do burn and are reported a fine of approximately \$1400 will be levied. Please direct any questions to Tyrone Township.

Fire Extinguisher Recall - November 2, 2017 - In conjunction with the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC), Kidde announced a recall to replace certain Kidde fire extinguishers. The replacement program was initiated because certain fire extinguishers can become clogged or require excessive force to activate, posing a risk of failure to discharge. In addition, the nozzle can detach with enough force to pose an impact hazard. The product recall involves two styles of Kidde disposable fire extinguishers: plastic handle fire extinguishers and plastic push-button fire extinguishers. **This recall involves both home and marine extinguishers.** Follow this link for more information and to obtain a replacement. <https://www.kidde.com/home-safety/en/us/support/product-alerts/recall-kidde-fire-extinguisher/>
